Fall 2025 Application Period: March 1, 2025, through May 1, 2025

Students who wish to apply for admission into the Medical Radiography Program for must complete the following requirements.

Attendance at an Information Session is <u>MANDATORY</u> for admission.
 Information Sessions are face-to-face on Central Campus. Online <u>registration</u> is required.
 Application Codes for the Medical Radiography Program will <u>ONLY</u> be available at Information Sessions.

Admission to San Jacinto College

Students must first apply and be admitted to SJC. If you are a first-time student to San Jac, you will need to provide official copies of transcripts, from all universities/colleges attended, to Enrollment Services for their evaluation.

• Official Transcripts for Application

When applying for the program, applicants must upload official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended, including SJC. Applicants will need to request official transcripts be sent to themselves, then scanned/saved as a PDF for upload. **Unofficial transcripts printed from college websites will not be accept.**

• Prerequisite Courses

Courses must be completed with a "C" or higher **prior to** the application deadline.

- * BIOL 2301/2101 Anatomy & Physiology I Lecture & Lab (5-year expiration from program start date)
- * ENGL 1301 Composition I
- * MATH 1314 College Algebra
- * RADR 1201 Introduction to Radiography (3-year expiration from program start date)

HESI A2 Exam

The HESI A2 Exam is a timed, computerized test with a 4.5-hour time limit that consists of questions over the following sections: Reading Comprehension, Grammar, Vocabulary & Knowledge, Anatomy & Physiology, and Math. Students must also complete the Learning Style section; however, it will not be scored. Applicants must submit an official HESI A2 Exam scoresheet with all five sections listed. Exam dates must be within two years of the application

period (May 2, 2023 – May 1, 2025) and be administered through the SJC Medical Imaging Department on Central Campus. Students may take the exam twice in an academic year.

Information on how to register for the exam can only be found at Information Sessions.

Degree Evaluations

Prior to submitting your application, using your SOS account, you will need to perform a Degree Evaluation "What-If" for the AAS in Medical Radiography, 2025-2026 Catalog Year.

• Clinical Health Requirements

Upon selection into the program, but prior to admission, students will be required to complete a criminal background check, urine drug/alcohol screening, and various other clinical health requirements (CPR, health, insurance, vaccinations, titers, physical exam, etc.).

Required GE Courses

Prior to the completion of the AAS in Medical Radiography, students will be required to complete the following GE courses with a grade of "C" or higher as part of the Degree Plan.

- * Humanities or Fine Arts (3 SCH)
- Psychology 2301 General Psychology

Completed application documents must be submitted online by the application deadline. Submissions outside the application period will not be considered. Online applications can be found on the Medical Radiography Program webpage under "Step 7: Apply to the Medical Radiography Program". Applicants must have a minimum GPA of **2.0** and be in **good academic standing**. Applications must be submitted during the application periods listed below.

- Full-Time Schedule (6–9-hour clinical rotations, 3–8-hour lecture/lab times weekly)
- Typical School Calendar is followed (Fall & Spring:16 weeks, Summer: 13 weeks)
